



Award in Equality and Diversity Level 2

Duration: 3 half days

Introduction/Summary

This City and Guilds Award will help develop learners understanding of the effects of stereotyping, prejudice and discrimination.

The qualification gives an understanding of how to describe inequality within society and define terms surrounding equality. Attendees will also start to understand the different characteristics that make us who we are. This qualification will strengthen the attendee's understanding of the different interests, beliefs, age, lifestyles, personal characteristics and cultural identities that we have in society.

It will delivered through trainer-led online sessions, additional research and self-study by attendees. The qualification is achieved by completion of 1 mandatory units, completing workbooks throughout the course duration.

Qualification Structure

The City and Guilds Level 2 Award in Equality and Diversity mandatory units;

- Understand what equality is
- Understand what diversity is
- Understand the effects of prejudice and discrimination
- Understand the ways in which people might choose to describe themselves
- Understand the effects of stereotyping and labelling

- Be able to explain why some people stereotype others
- Identify diversity that exists within society
- Describe how people may develop prejudices
- Describe factors and characteristics that make a person who they are
